

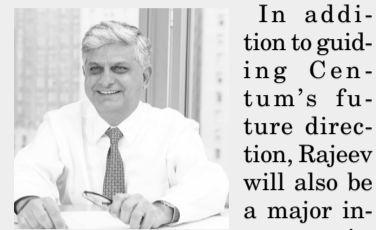

Centum appoints

LVB biz drops by
a per cent

South-based private sector bank, Lakshmi Vilas Bank (LVB) has declared its third quarter results for the current financial year. The bank stated that total business of the bank reached Rs 54,910 crore, as against Rs 55,851 crore, a decrease of 1.68 per cent.

Gross advances of the bank stood at Rs 24,123 crore as against Rs 25,231 crore, a y-o-y decline of 4.39 per cent, a release stated. Total deposits rose from Rs 30,620 crore to Rs 30,787 crore, registering y-o-y growth of 0.55 per cent.

TIFHL PAT up 25%

TI Financial Holdings Limited (TIFHL) has stated that the firm registered profit after tax for the quarter ended 31 December, 2018 at Rs 2.05 crore as against a profit of Rs 1.25 crore in the corresponding quarter of the previous year.

On a standalone basis profits after tax for the period were at Rs 32.27 crore as against Rs 25.79 crore registering a growth of 25 per cent.

Cholamandalam Investment & Finance Company Ltd, in which the Company holds 46.4 per cent stake, disbursed Rs 7,644 crore during the quarter compared to Rs 6,761 crore in the corresponding quarter of the previous year, registering a growth of 13 per cent. The aggregate disbursements for the period were at Rs 21,558 crore as against Rs 17,106 crore, registering a growth of 26 per cent.

IDBI wants LIC's
name in title

Chennai, Feb 5:

IDBI Bank, which was acquired by Life Insurance Corporation recently, has posted a steep rise in net loss to Rs 4,185.48 crore for the third quarter ended December 2018 as against a loss of Rs 1,524.31 crore in the corresponding quarter of the previous fiscal.

Reports have now stated that IDBI wants LIC's name in the title of the firm as it looks at losses equalling to Rs 7,787 crore combining the last two quarters alone, which is equal to 65 per cent amount that LIC pumped into it.

Total income decreased to Rs 6,190.94 crore for the quarter, compared with Rs 7,125.20 crore in the corresponding quarter a year ago, IDBI Bank said in a statement.

The bank's gross NPAs and the net NPA ratio improved to 29.67 per cent and 14.01 per cent, as against 31.78 per cent and 17.30 per cent respectively as of September 2018.

FOR E-COMM POLICY?

India's e-commerce sector may well face more changes in the coming weeks as the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) continues on its quest to make the new regulatory framework suit the industry according to the nation's needs.

Reports have stated that the department, formerly known as the Department of Industrial Policy and Promotion (DIPP) is looking to excuse itself from setting up a sector regulator. It will however continue to include the recently updated changes in FDI policy, reports have stated.

On the other hand, the government (reportedly) has set up a small working group constituting both angel investors and startup founders, to look into the issues faced by angel investors. It has been stated that the government could likely come up with a fresh notification on angel tax in a week.

Announced on 26 December, 2018, under Press Note 2, the new regulations will bar online marketplaces, that are backed by foreign investments, from selling products of the companies where they hold stakes in, as well as ban exclusive marketing arrangements.

Change never changes

On Monday (4 February), Min-



ister of State for Commerce and Industry, C R Chaudhary, filed a written reply to the query on changes in FDI for e-commerce and its impact saying, 'The FDI policy on e-commerce has remained unchanged. Better enforcement of this policy will contribute significantly to the growth of this sector over the medium and long term.'

In a Lok Sabha reply, Chaudhary also highlighted that a think tank on 'Framework for National Policy on e-commerce' was constituted by the Department of Commerce and a task force under the think tank was set up for preparing recommendations for India's National Policy on the sector.

'Department of Commerce formulated a draft policy document titled 'Electronic Commerce in India: Stakeholder Recommendations Received for a National Policy Framework' after consulting various stakeholders including concerned Ministries/ Departments, State Governments, apex industry chambers, associations and other organisations, taking into consideration their views/comments. The views and suggestions of various stakeholders were considered while drafting the above policy document,' he said.

\$50 BN WIPED OUT

Within a few days after the revised FDI rules came into effect, leading online retail marketplaces Amazon and Flipkart's parent Walmart together saw \$50 billion getting wiped off from their market capitalisation, reports stated.

The government's move has allegedly jeopardizing ambitious growth plans of large e-tailers like Amazon and Flipkart and consequently, Amazon shares tumbled on the Nasdaq by 5.38 per cent to \$1,626.23 per piece on Friday while NYSE-listed Walmart's stock price ended 2.06 per cent lower at \$93.86.

The reported market cap loss for Amazon is more than \$45 billion while for Walmart it is more than \$5 billion.

interdisciplinary panel to look into the feedback and comments made by e-commerce stakeholders on the draft. The old draft e-commerce policy had also called for the sector regulator.

The draft e-commerce policy was made public in August by the Ministry. However, the policy draft faced resistance from many departments and Ministries, which felt that the recommendations exceeded the Commerce Department's brief.

In 7 days....

On the same day, the DPIIT and Central Board of Direct Taxation (CBDT) met with investors and startups. The meet was headed by DPIIT Secretary, Ramesh Abhishek.

The meet was the outcome of

incessant protests by investors in the last few weeks following the government's notification on angel tax on 16 January.

'Have received many suggestions on angel tax issues; small working groups will be formed to suggest changes,' said Ramesh Abhishek.

'CBDT and DIPP have committed to coming up with a fresh notification to provide relief on angel tax within a week's time and some of us will be working with them during this period. The objective is to devise a mechanism through which startups can be differentiated from shell companies and get a blanket relief from angel tax,' said Sachin Taparia, who is a member of the newly formed committee, reported a media outlet.

Essel promoters sell shares
worth over Rs 1,050 cr

New Delhi, Feb 5 (PTI):

Essel group's promoter entities sold shares worth over Rs 1,050 crore in six listed group firms in open market between 25 January and 1 February, for paying off lenders who were not part of an agreement to prevent declaration of default on loans against pledged shares.

According to multiple regulatory filings by different promoter group entities of Essel group, shares of Zee Entertainment Enterprises, Dish TV, Zee Media Corporation, Siti Networks Ltd and Zee Learn were sold in open market.

Sources said the promoters sold the shares in order to pay off lenders who were not part of the pact announced on 27 January, under which 97 per cent of the group's lenders agreed not to classify loans against pledged shares as 'default'.



When contacted, Essel Group spokesperson said: 'Essel group confirms the mentioned information, which is as per regulatory filings'.

According to a series of regulatory filings, Essel group raised an amount of Rs 874.11 crore through sale of stake in its flagship firm Zee Entertainment Enterprises by its promoter entities Cyquator Media Services Pvt Ltd and Essel Corporate LLP selling 1.69 per cent and 0.85 per cent stake, respectively, between 25 January to 1 February.

Other promoter group firms World Crest Advisors LLP (0.86 per cent),

Direct Media Distribution Ventures (0.80 per cent) and Veena Investments Pvt Ltd (0.35 per cent) sold shares worth Rs 97.34 crore in Dish TV during the period. In Zee Media Corporation, ARM Infra & Utilities Pvt Ltd (2.38 per cent) and 25FPS Media Pvt Ltd (3.09 per cent) sold shares worth Rs 45.05 crore.

Transaction value has been calculated based on weighted average price of the stock on the day of sale and the number of shares sold.

On 25 January, Essel group companies had come under massive selling pressure, plummeting up to 33 per cent, and suffered a combined erosion of Rs 13,352 crore in market valuation.

The next day, Essel group chairman Subhash Chandra said his company is in a financial mess and blamed it on aggressive bets on infra.

Mallya to lodge appeal as UK
gears up to deliver him back

Chennai, Feb 5:

No sooner had the UK Home Secretary ordered the extradition of liquor baron Vijay Mallya, the latter has announced that he will lodge an appeal on the decision.

The Indian multimillionaire chairman of Kingfisher beer has allegations of £1bn fraud to his name.

Mallya who lives in a £11.5 million mansion at Hertfordshire, said on Twitter, 'I could not initiate the appeal process before a decision by the Home Secretary. Now I will initiate the appeal process.'

He has been fighting the extradition order and has previously dismissed the allegations that he fled India leaving a trail of £977 million worth of debts as 'ludicrous'. He has

said he made an 'unconditional' offer to pay what he owed in full in July 2018.

Sajid Javid, the UK Home Secretary, on Monday formally ordered Mallya, who owns two multimillion UK properties and until last year had two superyachts, to be extradited, stating that the 63-year-old businessman is 'accused in India of conspiracy to defraud, making false representations and money laundering offences'. A judge ruled in December 2018 that Mallya had misrepresented how loans from Indian banks were used and referred the decision on his extradition to Javid.

Mallya is alleged to have knowingly misled largely India State-owned banks about the fortunes of his failing Kingfisher airline, before laundering the cash to fund his Formula One team and other projects.
